A RESOLUTION ADOPTING DOCUMENT PERTAINING TO IOWA COUNTY'S COMPLIANCE WITH TITLE VI PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964.

WHEREAS, Iowa county has been a recipient of federal assistance from the U.S. Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, in receiving such financial assistance Iowa County is mandated to comply with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; and

WHEREAS, in order to continue receiving federal financial assistance from the U.S. Department of Transportation and the Iowa Department of Transportation the adoption of certain documents and establishment of certain programs is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors that;

- 1. The Iowa County Engineer, Nick Amelon, is hereby designated the Title VI Coordinator for the Iowa County Secondary Roads.
- 2. The Iowa County Title VI Plan is hereby adopted and the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and Title VI Coordinator are authorized to sign said plan where required.
- 3. The Standard DOT Title VI Assurances are hereby adopted and the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to sign said document where required.
- 4. The Title VI Notice to the public is hereby adopted and shall be posted where other public notices are displayed in the Iowa County Courthouse, Annex Building, and County Engineer's Office. Furthermore, said notice shall be placed on the County's official website.
- 5. The Title VI Coordinator is authorized to take any other actions necessary and/or recommended by the Iowa Department of Transportation, or other designated authority to comply with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
